One manuscript justifies the assumption that he lived at 'y Gesail Gyfarch ' in Caernarfonshire; he also wrote a poem on the death of **Elis Wyn** of that place in 1624. Seventeen *cywyddau* and nine *englynion* by him are extant, the greater part being written in praise of, or on the death of, members of the families of **Gwydir**, **Glynlifon**, **Bodwrda**, etc., one being written to Huw Gwyn of Berth Ddu when he was sheriff in 1609. Some of the *englynion* were written to **Ifan Tew (the younger?)** when he sought appointment as magistrate.
