His compositions include eulogies of Hywel Colunwy (not of Hywel ap Siencyn), Dafydd Deudwr, Watcyn ap Tomas ap Rhoser, Dafydd ap Gruffudd Deudwr ([Peniarth MS 64](#), f.243), and [Dafydd ab Owain](#), abbot of Strata Marcella, and poems of a religious nature. It appears from the contents of 'Tebic ywr byd kyngyd kaeth' that towards the end of his life he became blind.
