His poems are preserved in Peniarth MS 76 , Peniarth MS 312 , Llanstephan MS 118 , Cardiff MS. 7, Cardiff MS. 49, B.M. Add. MS. 14997, and NLW MS 728D . Among them is a *cywydd* which John Puleston the elder ('Sion pilstwn hen') of Bersham caused to be written to John, abbot of Valle Crucis, and an *englyn* to the steeple of Wrexham church, 1507.
