

DAVIES, HUGH TUDWAL (1847 - 1915), farmer and poet

Born at Mynachdy, Clynnog, Caernarfonshire - he was a nephew of **Robert Hughes**, Uwchlaw'r Ffynnon (1811 - 1892). At the age of 18 the family moved to Yr Orsedd Fawr, Llanybi; in 1872 he settled in Brynllaeth, Llŷn. He m, a daughter of Capt. John Hughes, Gellidara. He wrote many *englynion* and a few *cywyddau*; he won prizes at eisteddfodau held at Pwllheli, 1875, and Caernarvon, 1880 and 1894. His later years were spent at Llwyn'rhudol, Aber-erch. He died in April 1915 at Gellidara and was buried at Penrhos, near Pwllheli.
