Born at Creigiau'r Bleiddiau, Cerrig-y-drudion. He was an able harpist of whom [Edward Jones](#) (Bardd y Brenin, 1752 - 1824) says that he had a natural gift for music and had a beautiful touch on the harp. There is a local tradition that he died suddenly with his fingers still clutching the harp-strings. He died in June 1766 and was buried in Cerrig-y-drudion churchyard.
