No details about him are known, but a number of his poems, *cywyddau* and *englynion*, remain in manuscript. They include poems in praise of North Wales gentry, including Humphrey Hughes of Gwerclys, and John Eyton and his wife, a marriage poem addressed to Andrew Meredydd of Glan Tanad, and an elegy on the poet **Siôn Tudur**. His *englynion* include some written in bardic controversy (*ymryson*) with Morys Powel.
