A member apparently of the **Nannau** family. He was contemporary with **Dafydd ap Maredudd ap Tudur**, fl. 1460. Some examples of his work exist in manuscript, and these include an *englyn* written to the poet **Gruffudd Phylip** (NLW MS 643B (39b)), a *cywydd* to the sons of **Ieuan Fychan** of Pengwern (died c. 1458) (Cardiff MS. 83 (28b)); NLW MS 3049D (500)), and another to Dafydd Llwyd ap Gruffudd Deuddwr (**Peniarth MS 64** (236)).
