Nothing is known of his life. A few examples of his work remain in manuscripts, these being *cywyddau* addressed to members of the *Ynys y Maengwyn* and Gogerddan families (Brogyntyn MS. 2 (480, 480b)), and a satirical poem to itinerant bards, or *clerwyr*, many of whom are mentioned by name (Peniarth MS 188 (85)).
