

## HUW CEIRIOG (fl. c. 1560-1600), poet

**Name:** Huw Ceirioig

**Gender:** Male

**Occupation:** poet

**Area of activity:** Poetry

**Author:** Ray Looker

A native of Denbighshire who graduated in the fourth bardic grade at the Caerwys eisteddfod of 1568 ([Peniarth MS 132](#) (59)). Some of his poems remain in manuscript, and these include light-hearted *cwyddau* on love and nature, others written to [Simon Thelwall](#) of Plas y Ward, [John Salusbury](#) of Llyweni (elegy), and one in praise of Plas Moelyrch. He also wrote an *englyn* on the above-mentioned eisteddfod. The following manuscripts contain examples of his work: B.M. Add. MS. 14894; Cardiff MS. 63; [Llanstephan MS 118](#); [NLW MS 3048D](#); [NLW MS 6496C](#), [NLW MS 8330B](#); Peniarth MS 84 ([Llyfr Dafydd Cayo](#)), Peniarth MS 104.

The name Hywel Ceirioig appears instead of Huw in some manuscript lists of the 1568 Caerwys graduate poets (e.g. Peniarth MS 121 (215), Peniarth MS 144 (268)); and a bardic controversy occurred between Hywel Ceirioig, [William Liñ](#), [Ieuan Tew](#) and [Siôn Phylip](#), and the two poets, [William Cynwal](#) and [Huw Liñ](#) ([NLW MS 3021F](#) (455); [NLW MS 675A](#) (24b)). The connection between these two names has not yet been established.
