A native (apparently) of North Wales. Some examples of his work exist in manuscript, and these include poems written to various members of the **Nannau**, **Corsygedol**, **Cefnamwlch**, and Egryn families between 1627 and 1644. Six *englynion* written by him in thanks for an oar are also found. No details concerning his life are known.
