A native of Cyfeiliog. Two examples of his work have been found in manuscript, these being elegies upon members of the landed families of Carno and Manafon, Montgomeryshire. A genealogical manuscript in the hand of [Gruffudd Hiraethog \(Peniarth MS 176\)](#) acknowledges a similar manuscript of Hywel's, but no existing example of the poet's genealogical work is known at present.
