Much of his work remains in manuscript, and this includes poems written to members of the Abertanad, Mold, **Ynys-ymaengwyn**, and **Gwydir** families, another addressed to **Dafydd ab Owain**, abbot of Strata Marcella, a satire on Flint, and satirical *englynion* forming part of the bardic controversy, or *ymryson*, between **Guto'r Glyn** and Ieuan.
