A native, apparently, of the Clywedog Valley in Montgomeryshire. Some of his work exists in manuscript, and this includes *cwyddau* composed between c. 1577 and 1596, to members of the Cefn Digoll, Garthery, Maiwyd, [Mathafarn](#), and Moelyrch families, and a *cwydd* to the trout.
