A native apparently of Glyn Ceiriog, Denbighshire. Nothing is known about him, but a number of *cwyddau* and *englynion* composed by him, c. 1594 to 1610, have survived. He wrote poems to various contemporary North Wales gentry, including *Owain Holant* of Plas Berw, Anglesey, *Hwmffrai ap Huw* of Gwerclys, *Rhobert Wyn* of Foelas, *Edwart ap Dafydd* of Rhiwlas, *Edward ap Morus* of Llansilin, *Owain Brurtwyn* (Brereton) of Bwras (Borras), *Huw Morus ap Ieuau* of Cefn Hir and Siôn Eutun of Coed Llai (Leeswood).
