One of the last of the 'Gogynfeirdd.' No details of his career are known, but an *awdl* composed by him to **Hopcyn ap Tomas** of Ynysdawy, Glamorganshire, is preserved in the 'Red Book of Hergest' and some other manuscripts. It is also contained in *The Myvyrian Archaiology of Wales*, but there the poet's name is given as Iorwerth Llwyd ab y Gargam.
