Jesus Coll. MS. 18 (30) and [NLW MS 1559B](#) (664) describe him as the father of the poet [Owain Gwynedd](#). A number of his poems remain in manuscript, including *cywyddau* and *englynion* of controversy or *ymryson*, addressed to [Huw Arwystli](#), love poems, and various other *englynion* which include two apparently composed on an obscure incident involving the removal of the poet's books and other belongings.
