He hailed from Aberdaron. His patrons included the families of **Bodeon**, **Bodfel**, **Cochwillan**, **Glynllifon**, and **Gwydir**. He was also one of the poets who wrote an elegy on the death of **Tudur Aled**. According to **Peniarth MS 122** (122) he was buried at Nevin, though other sources state that he was buried at Llanegwad, Carmarthenshire. A selection of his work was published by **Myrddin Fardd** in *Cynfeirdd Lleyl*.
