Examples of his work exist in MSS., including a love poem, an awdl in praise of Ewyas, an elegy to [Sir Charles Herbert](#), another to reconcile William Herbert of Colebrook with William Siôn ap Rhoser of Wern-du, and poems in praise of [William Evans](#), chancellor and treasurer of Llandaff. [Dafydd Benwyn](#), in his elegy to the poet, refers to the poems he composed to the chancellor.
