

## OWAIN ab EDWIN (died 1105), a landowner in Tegeingl (modern Flintshire).

He and his brother, Uchtryd, were the reputed sons of **Edwin ap Gronw**, a great-great-grandson of **Hywel Dda** by Iwerydd, half-sister of **Bleddyn ap Cynfyn**. Though he assisted earl Hugh of Chester in the latter's abortive expedition against Gwynedd in 1098, his daughter, **Angharad**, married **Gruffudd ap Cynan**. His son, Gronw, was the father of **Christina**, second wife of **Owain Gwynedd**. He should not be confused with his father's cousin - also Owain ab Edwin - of the main royal line of Deheubarth.
