A native, presumably, of South Wales. Nothing is known of his life, but a few of his poems remain in manuscript. These include two *cywyddau* to Sir Rhys ap Thomas of Dynevor when he was a young man (*Peniarth MS 83* (70), *Llanstephan MS 30* (435)). His son, *Dafydd Fynglwyd*, was also a poet.
