Born 12 November 1892 in Cymer, Porth, Rhondda, fifth son of David and Sarah Davies. Before taking up a musical career he worked in the mines and during World War I as an engineer in the navy. He was educated in the University College at Cardiff. He won a scholarship at the Royal College of Music in London, and sang in opera and held concerts in the U.S.A., Canada and Australia. In 1922 he joined the British National Opera Co. and remained with that company for the rest of his career. He portrayed Rudolfo in London in 1922, and in 1924 he sang the leading role in the first public performance of *Hugh the Drover* (Vaughan Williams) in His Majesty's Theatre. He was recording to Lordon in 1924 the Safig the leading fole in the first public performance of *Public* (Vadaginal Williams) in First Majesty's Theorem Proposed the professional performance of *Public* (Paginal Williams) in First Majesty's Theorem Professional Professio 1958.
