Among them were two newspapers - The Demetian Mirror; or Aberystwyth Reporter and Visitants' Informant ..., which appeared once a week from 15 August 1840 till 31 October 1840, and The Aberystwyth Chronicle and Illustrated Times, a weekly paper published between 9 June 1855 and 22 December 1855. The printing work from the Cox press was usually well produced.
